

# Blythe//Blanket

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

One square =  $15\% \times 15\% in/40 \times 40cm$ .

### **MATERIALS**

A pair of US 8/5mm knitting needles.

The blanket was knitted in many combinations of colours, or only

a few. It is up to your preference.

Noro *Kureyon* or *Silk Garden*: 50g skeins.

Noro *Ito* or *Viola*: 200g balls.

**Small:** 9 squares (900g total - approx 18 x 50g or 4.5 x 200g) **Medium:** 16 squares (1600g total - approx 32 x 50g or 8 x 200g) **Large:** 25 squares (2500g total - approx 50 x 50g or 12.5 x 200g)

## **TENSION**

18 sts and 24 rows = 4in/10cm square measured over stockinette stitch using US 8/5mm needles.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

**k** knit; **p** purl; **patt** pattern; **rep** repeat; **sl** slip; **st(s)** stitch(es).

### *INSTRUCTIONS*

To make one square:

With US 8/5mm needles, cast on 70 sts.

Row 1 (RS): With yarn A, knit to end.

Row 2: With yarn A, purl to end.

Rows 3 and 4: With yarn B, knit to end.

**Row 5:** With yarn A, k6, [sl2, k6] to end.

**Row 6:** With yarn A, p6, [sl2, p6] to end.

Row 7: As row 5, but with yarn B.

Row 8: With yarn B, knit to end.

**Row 9:** As row 1.

**Row 10:** As row 2.

Rows 11 and 12: As rows 3 and 4.

**Row 13:** With yarn A, k2, sl2, [k6, sl2] to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 14:** With yarn A, p2, sl2, [p6, sl2] to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 15: As row 13, but with yarn B.

Row 16: With yarn B, knit to end.

These 16 rows form the patt.

Rep the last 16 rows until work measures 15% in/40cm, or all yarn

is used up.

Cast off.


## Finishing

Join squares together as desired (the model shown has the squares joined in sets of 3, with a cast off edge of one square sewn to the side of another square.) ■









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
